<u>Net Neutrality</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Believes that we “must preserve Internet freedom here and abroad, so that the online world can flourish free from heavy-handed government intervention”</li> <li>• Led the charge to replace the 2015 Open Internet Order with the Restoring Internet Freedom Order</li> <li>• Argued that the FCC did not have the proper authority to mandate net neutrality rules absent a congressional directive</li> <li>• Also argued that granting ISP’s the freedom to manage their networks is best way to spur innovation and manage network traffic in emergency situations</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Believes that ISP’s must be heavily regulated and restricted to prevent them from hurting consumers</li> <li>• Dedicated to “fighting to protect net neutrality”</li> <li>• Voted with the Obama-era FCC to impose and expand net neutrality</li> <li>• Argued that net neutrality rules are the only way to prevent a “two-tiered internet” where ISP’s are “gatekeepers”</li> </ul>
<u>Broadband</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Believes that “closing the digital divide” is essential to modern life in America</li> <li>• Focused heavily on building out broadband infrastructure and networks to better serve rural communities that have historically been neglected in internet buildout</li> <li>• Supported efforts to improve broadband maps</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Believes that the digital divide is a problem that was worsened by the policies of the Trump administration</li> <li>• Focused on “ensuring access to the internet for students caught in the Homework Gap”</li> <li>• Continuing the effort to improve broadband maps to support buildout</li> </ul>
<u>Spectrum</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Freed up significant amounts of licensed and unlicensed spectrum through a series of public auctions</li> <li>• This spectrum is being used by wireless carriers, ISP’s, and other companies to build out our 5G infrastructure</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Has taken steps to begin freeing up more of the mid-band spectrum at auction</li> </ul>
